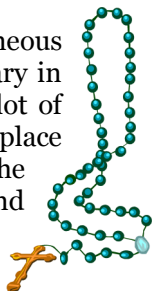


ROSARY COAST TO COAST

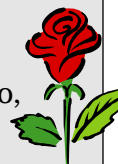

SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

Are you employed by a Catholic parish or school? Do you regularly volunteer with minors? If the answer is yes to either of these questions, you should be aware of the diocesan safe environment requirements. The primary obligations for any employee and for all volunteers who work with minors are:

1. Required to attend an adult safe environment training (VIRTUS),
2. Required to sign a Background Disclosure and Authorization form which will allow the diocese to conduct a criminal background screening,
3. Required to sign a diocesan Code of Conduct every year that you are employed or actively volunteering.

The Code of Conduct for 2019-2020 was released in July. If you fall into one of the above categories and have not signed the 2019-2020 Code of Conduct please contact St. Vincent Parish or School office. You may also contact the Office of Child and Youth Protection with any questions or concerns, childandyouthprotection@dioscg.org or 417-866-0841.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)

St. Vincent de Paul Church is now a part of **CarePortal!** **CarePortal** is a ministry set up to meet the needs of children in the area. It is an online platform in which immediate needs of children can be submitted for viewing by churches and other caring individuals who want to help. The needs are identified by child welfare professionals who can legitimately vouch for their crisis. These are real needs. Once a need is identified, an email goes out to churches that are registered with **CarePortal**. **Church members can choose to respond and meet the need or simply pray for the children and families.
