A Season for Giving

As we prepare for Christmas through our celebration of Advent, St. Vincent de Paul Parish is again sponsoring the Foster Care Christmas project, the collection of gifts for children living in foster care. In addition to foster children, the parish will also assist Whole Health Outreach to provide Christmas gifts for children in the Ellington area.

Beginning this weekend, November 23-24, gift tags will be posted on the bulletin board in the gathering area. Each child will have four tags posted: two for items the child needs (clothing, socks, etc.) and two tags for things the child wishes for (toys, etc.). You are invited to take a tag and purchase the requested gift. Return the tag with the item by December 8. *If you bring your gift on a weekend, please leave it on the designated table in the gathering area. Gifts brought during the week and all gift cards must come to the parish office.* If you have a question about a gift or cannot find the particular item, please call the parish office at 335-7667 for assistance. Each gift has to be checked and recorded so the gifts should not be wrapped. However, clothing should be packed in gift boxes. Because the children receive many used items throughout the year, please send new gifts only.

Most of us are unable to accept a foster child into our home, but this is one small way we can assist foster parents who are generously caring for these children. In addition to the gift you may be giving, please remember to pray for the foster children, their families, and the foster families who care for them.
