**RCIA Update:** Seven Inquirers to the Catholic Faith have been attending weekly formation classes since early September. They are now ready to come before the parish this weekend during the **Rite of Welcome**. Through this rite they express their desire to continue their study of Jesus Christ through the teachings of the Catholic Church. There is a change in identity where those previously known as Inquirers become Catechumens (the unbaptized) and Candidates (those already baptized). The Church officially welcomes them as members seeking unity with our community of faith. This rite is the first official acknowledgment and blessing by the Church for those seeking Christian initiation and each will receive a Bible to help them embrace God's word. They will also be marked with the sign of the cross and receive a cross as a remembrance of Jesus' love poured out for us on the cross. May the community of St. Vincent de Paul continue to keep these candidates in prayer and welcome them into our community of faith.
