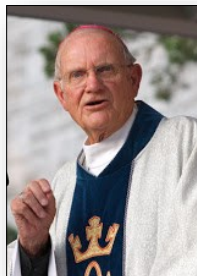

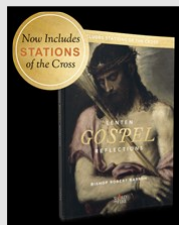
## Welcome Bishop Emeritus Leibrecht

### Laudate App

Laudate is a Catholic app for iPhone and android users. You can search "Laudate" in the App store and download for free onto your phone. When you open your app, the first link is to the "Daily Readings and Saint of the Day." When you open the link, there are many options for the daily readings, reflections, daily bible verse, daily prayer, multiple podcasts, etc. "Daily Readings" is only one section of the Laudate App. Download this app and start exploring. It is a treasure trove of all things Catholic, including the Bible, Catechism, Mass, Prayers, Novenas, etc.
