Nor do I really know myself, and the fact that I think I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you. Therefore, will I trust you always though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death. I will not fear, for you are ever with me and you will never leave me to face my perils alone.

# St. Vincent de Paul Small Discipleship Groups

The parish had a very successful start for the Discipleship study sessions this past Fall. The Discipleship Small Groups will resume soon with new topics and materials. Parishioners will have the option of staying in current groups or forming new groups. This is open to all parishioners regardless of whether you participated in the Fall sessions.

Small groups are 8-10 people who meet regularly – usually once per week. Their purpose is to foster fellowship while learning and growing in our Catholic faith. Groups can meet at someone's home or request a space here at Church. If you wish to have refreshments or even a meal, that is up to the group. We are trying to keep this as flexible as possible.

The first session will begin the week of February 23. Parishioners will have the option to choose one of five "Programs" – each has a unique format (see back of this sheet for more information).

You can get together with people you know and form your own small group of 8-10 people; OR sign up individually and you will be placed with a group according to your preferred topic and meeting time. If you were in a group in the Fall, you can stay in that group or choose to join a different one.

Again, the registration form is available on our parish website in a fillable format. If you would be interested in being a facilitator for a group, please check the box on the form. There will be a special training for facilitators prior to February 23.

The materials will be provided, however a small donation to cover the cost would be appreciated.

So please look over the options, talk to your family & friends, then go to our parish website and sign up online. We are asking for registration to be completed by February 10.

We plan to have samples of the materials in the gathering space after Masses on the weekend of February 1 - 2. Committee members will also be available to answer questions.




