

St. Vincent de Paul Church joined Care Portal in October 2019. Care Portal is a ministry set up to meet the needs of children in our area. It is an online platform in which immediate needs of children are submitted by caseworkers and can be viewed by churches and other caring individuals who want to help. Since our parish joined Care Portal last fall, we have met multiple needs in our community and surrounding communities. Individuals from St. Vincent Parish have donated items such as car seats, clothing, furniture, bedding, fire extinguishers, and bus passes, just to name a few. We have served over 23 children. 
Become Part of a Small Group!
