

## **Diocesan Development Fund**

The Diocesan Development Fund Campaign (DDF) is the annual campaign for the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau. The funds raised through the campaign advance the mission of the Catholic Church through a host of ministries that assist families, parishes, and the Diocese as a whole.

This year St. Vincent de Paul's parish goal is \$250,000 with a participation goal of 600 households. Do you hear Him knocking on the door of your heart? Come and join in teaching God's little children! Parish School of Religion (PSR) teachers are needed for grades 1-2 on Wednesdays evenings from 6:00 - 7:30 p.m. (October - May).

#### **PSR (Parish School of Religion)**

Recognizing that parents are the primary teachers of the faith to their children, our Parish School of Religion exists to help parents of our families who attend public school. Our PSR program exists to support parents in teaching faithfulness and understanding the life of the Church. Because of the pandemic this year, our PSR program on Wednesday evenings will take a new shape. We are going to have two learning tracks.

**Track 1** will be weekly. This will include our First Graders (First Sacraments) who are beginning to learn about the faith for the very first time in a formal setting. It will also include our Second Graders (Second Sacraments) who are doing the final preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion. In addition, our weekly track will include Seventh Graders and Eighth Graders who are preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation after Eighth Grade. This track will begin on Wednesday, October 7, and will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

**Track 2** will be twice a month on the first and third Wednesdays. This will include the rest of our students in grades 3, 4, 5 and 6. These four grades, along with their parents and *all* parents of grades 1, 2, 7 and 8, will come together in the Church for a family learning session. At the end of the family learning session, grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 will have "homework" to take home and do over the next two weeks. This track will begin Wednesday, October 7, and will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Understandably, this is different from previous years, but this is due to the pandemic. It is necessary to meet weekly with our children preparing for Sacraments and help them prepare for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation. For the other grades, we hope to provide a good curriculum by meeting with them twice a month and giving them their religion homework to do in between gatherings. Even with the different and unusual, we hope to provide a good faith program for our young children and their parents.

## **Virtual Options for Safely Connecting with Others**

**Editor's Note:** Please be aware that when using technology, safety measures should be in place to protect you and the people with whom you interact. This month's article provides a snapshot of different online platforms that can be used to interact and connect with others during this time of health crisis, at your own discretion, with a general description of the pros and cons of each platform. Next4

month's article will provide tangible information about how caring adults can create safer environments through using online platforms to interact with others, and will provide information about how to best monitor the child's use of the Internet, as well.

#### Introduction

The media today has inundated all of us with terms and reports such as: "Stay at Home," "Social Distancing," "Self-Quarantine," and, "Non-essential Businesses such as Bars and Restaurants Ordered Closed." So then, how does one connect with family members, friends, acquaintances, our colleagues from work, people with our ministries and the children who may be in our care (albeit remotely), while also doing it safely and still protecting youth?



For the typical "non-techie" person, it's going to take a little time and lots of patience, but in this world of ever-changing technology, it is possible to continue moving forward with the self-isolation dilemma while also connecting with others.

#### **Options for Connecting**

The simplest option for one to connect is by making a phone call. Whether one has a landline phone or a cell phone, all one has to do is

use the device's speakerphone option and any number of people can sit around the phone and easily join in a conversation.

Video-calling options are a fabulous way for people to stay connected with face -to-face capabilities while still practicing social distancing mandates.

If a person's computer, cell phone or tablet has an Internet or WIFI connection and a web-cam, that person can utilize the device for video-calls by using a free **Skype** application (app) download. Up to ten people can join in a video-call using Skype. If everyone is simply using Skype, the video-call is completely free if you each have WIFI, regardless of where you are located. Users only need to pay when using the premium Skype features like voice mail, texts or making voice calls to a landline or cell phones that don't also have the Skype app.

Another option is utilizing Apple's **FaceTime** app. If you and the person you're tying to connect with both have an Apple device like an iPhone, you can easily create a free FaceTime video-call with each other. One can also create a Group FaceTime with up to 32 Apple devices such as an iPhone, iPad or even a Mac. Unfortunately, this video-calling technique only works for the devices that support FaceTime, so Android users won't be able to join in the video conversation. Additionally, one may have to update the Apple iOS for the video -calling to work on their device.<sup>1</sup>

If one does not have an Apple device, one can download the free **Google Duo** app, which is a video-calling version of Apple's FaceTime. Similar to (Continued on next page)

**Virtus Sessions** 

VIRTUS Protecting God's Children is the adult safe-environment program offered by the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau. The Diocese requires all adult employees and volunteers who have substantial contact with children to attend the seminar.

Due to the Corona Virus and the ever-changing protocols for public gatherings, the Diocese has taken the precautionary step of making available an online option for the training. This is a temporary action and, hopefully, live training will continue. Additional information can be found at <a href="https://www.virtus.org">www.virtus.org</a>.

Check availability for additional dates/locations on the VIRTUS website. To attend a seminar you must pre-register with your full legal name. Pre-registration is necessary: Go to www.virtus.org and click on the yellow link labeled "Registration" (you may either view a list of sessions or begin the registration process). To register for a specific session, select "Begin the Registration Process". From the pulldown menu, select "Springfield-Cape Girardeau". Follow the online prompts, completing the Code of and Conduct entering information for a background screening. If you are unable to register online, please contact the parish office.

# **Updating Your New Code of Conduct**

If you completed the Virtus session prior to July 2020, it is now time to complete a new Code of Conduct. Diocesan policy states all Employees, Clergy, Religious and Volunteers, including Sport Coaches, who work/volunteer in parishes and come in contact with children must sign a copy of the Code of Conduct **each year**.

Please follow the online steps to read the new Code of Conduct for 2020-2021. (If you unable to get online, please contact the parish office for a copy of the form.)

- 1. Go to: <a href="http://dioscg.org/">http://dioscg.org/</a>
- 2. Click on the 'Ministries/Offices' section found at the top of the page.
- 3. Scroll down until you get to 'Child and Youth Protection'
- 4. Scroll down to the 'Forms' Section.
- 5. Click on the one that applies: 2020-2021 Code of Conduct Adults ENGLISH 2020-2021 Code of Conduct Adults SPANISH
- 6. Read the Code of Conduct.
- 7. Print out the last page.
- 8. Answer the top five questions and sign/date the bottom of the form.
- 9. Return to Beverly in the parish office.

Thank you for helping to keep children safe!

Skype, Google Duo works cross platforms, which means that unlike FaceTime, Android devices can connect with Apple devices using just one app. Duo at this time only supports eight people in a group video-call.

Another option for video-calling is the **Google Hangouts** app. This download, free in the U.S. and Canada, allows members to initiate and participate in text, voice or video-calls, either one-on-one or in a group. The Hangouts apps are available for iOS and Android devices. You'll need a Google account, such as a Gmail account or Google Plus account, to use the Hangouts program. Up to 25 people can join a video Hangout.

The **Zoom** app, available for iOS and Android devices, is another option for remote conferencing or simple video-calling. Zoom allows free, one-on-one video calls or large groups. Unfortunately, the free video-calls can only last up to forty minutes in length. After that, there is a monthly subscription charge, but the premium video-calls can last up to 24 hours and support as many as 100 callers.

The most popular video-calling app for the socially-connected Generation Z (those born between 1996-2010) is the free download **Houseparty** app, available for iOS and Android devices. Although Houseparty is limited to only eight video-callers, a user can have several "rooms" open at a time, the idea being that one can go from to room to room like at a real house party.

The **WhatsApp** download, available for iOS and Android devices, is popularly known worldwide for instant messaging, and is also free. WhatsApp also has a video-calling platform that allows up to four people to connect together at a time.

The **Facebook Messenger** app, available for iOS and Android devices, is another alternative for video-calling one-on-one or in groups.

This list of video-calling options is not completely exhaustive, because new options appear constantly. The best option for video calling depends on the type of device that a person uses.

#### **Concerns for Trusted Adults**

As with any type of technology, a parent should monitor or at least be aware when a child or teen connects with others in a video-call. Just as some people will take advantage of a pandemic to price gouge, a child molester will use the pandemic as an opportunity to try to gain video access to a bored or lonely child or teen, who is forced to stay home, by offering companionship.

Another safety tip is for a parent to insist that parental permission is required for the download of each App on a mobile device. This is easily facilitated by a parent retaining the password that is required to install a new App on the device.<sup>2</sup>

Technology continues to rapidly change. Parents and all of us who are charged with protecting children must continue our efforts to stay abreast of the many new devices, software programs and the latest apps that may be used by young people and child molesters seeking to manipulate and sexually abuse children.
