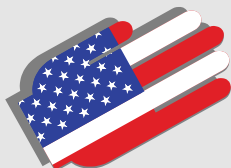

Father Rick and Father Brian Away This Week

Normally at the end of October, priests and permanent deacons of the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau gather for the annual **Clergy Institute**. This is a time for regeneration among the priests and permanent deacons and it is the only time in the year that they gather for prayer, study, and relaxation. Because of the Coronavirus Pandemic and the need for “social distancing,” the Clergy Institute will not take place in the way it has in the past. Smaller gatherings will be held with the priests and permanent deacons. Some of the smaller gatherings will take place next week and at other times.
