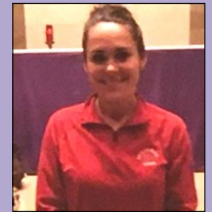

Mark your calendars! St. Vincent CCW will resume meetings this month. All women of the parish are invited. More information and guidelines will follow.

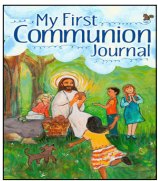

First Communion Gifts

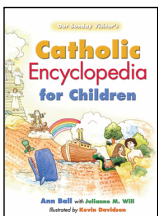

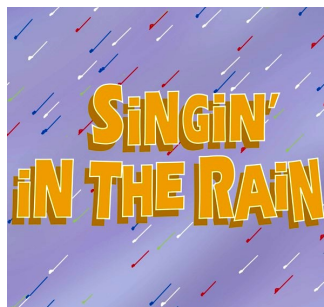
What is Totus Tuus?



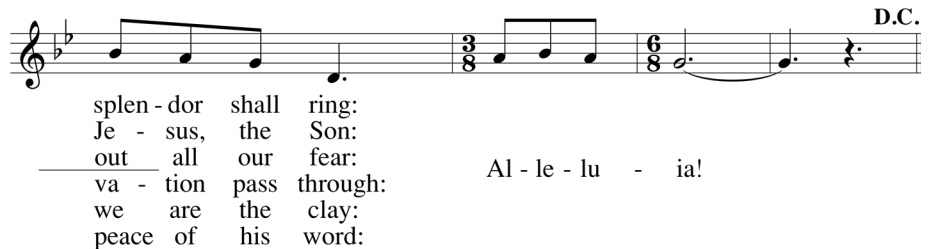
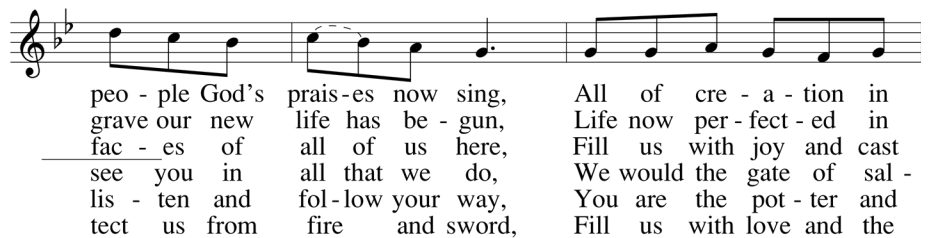
