

# Diocesan Development Fund Update

Generosity to the Diocesan Development Fund means support to various ministries! Because of the generosity of DDF donors, the diocese can support Catholic Schools, Campus Ministries, Religious Education, Faith Formation, Family Ministries, and Youth Ministries (including Camp Re-NEW-All and Totus Tuus).

**Update:** Across the diocese, \$1,678,941 (63%) has been pledged toward the goal of \$2,650,000. To date our parish has given \$220,251 (88.1%) toward our \$250,000 goal. We currently have 442 (78.9%) parish families participating toward our 560 (35% of parishioners) participant goal. This is great! Thank you. However we have a way to go before we reach our goal!


### **Communication Builds Community**



### **Celebrating the** Sacraments Celebrando los Sacramentos

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)




