# Phase 1 of Campus Planning at St. Vincent de Paul

The **first part** of Phase 1 is complete! The **new rectory** is finished and the priests have been able to move into their new environment. During the month of July, watch the Sunday bulletin for "Open House" opportunities for people to come by and take a look at the new place!

Currently, the **second part** of Phase 1 is underway. In early July, Midwest Environmental Studies will remove the asbestos from the ceiling texture of the old rectory and also remove the asbestos floor tile and mastic. Once the asbestos has been removed, the old rectory will be razed and the lot cleared for new parking for the church.

## **Diocesan Development Fund Update**

Generosity to the Diocesan Development Fund means support to various ministries! Because of the generosity of DDF donors, the diocese can support Catholic Schools, Campus Ministries, Religious Education, Faith Formation, Family Ministries, and Youth Ministries (including Camp Re-NEW-All and Totus Tuus).

**Update:** Across the diocese, \$2,093,129 (79%) has been pledged toward the goal of \$2,650,000. To date our parish has given \$234,530 (93.8%) toward our \$250,000 goal. We currently have 488 (87.1%) parish families participating toward our 560 (35% of parishioners) participant goal. This is great! Thank you. However we have a way to go before we reach our goal!

**Marriage**: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)

**Matrimonio**: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina parroquial por lo menos con **seis meses** de antelación. (Si usted ha estado casado antes, una anulación del matrimonio puede necesitar ser hecha primero.)

**Baptism**: Your family needs to be registered in the parish for three months prior to the baptism. It is necessary to schedule baptismal preparation classes six weeks prior to your child's baptism. 




