St. Joseph, Patron of Travelers



In this month of road trips and cross-country trekking, who should we turn to for protection? Ask St. Joseph. He was the one who safeguarded Mary and Jesus as they traveled 40 miles from Bethlehem to Egypt to escape Herod's soldiers. Today, it would be about a 40 minute car ride. For St. Joseph and Mary, it would have taken them 10-12

hours walking! The following is a short prayer from an early 20th-century prayer book, which asks for St. Joseph's intercession and protection while traveling.

O St. Joseph, who accompanied Jesus and Mary in all their journeys, and who has been called the patron of all travelers, accompany us in this journey that we are about to undertake. Be our guide and our protector; watch over us; preserve us from all accidents and dangers to soul and body; support us in our fatigue, and aid us to sanctify it by offering it to God. Make us ever mindful that we are strangers, sojourners here below; that heaven is our true home; and help us to persevere on the straight road that leads thereunto. We ask you especially to protect and aid us in the last great voyage from time to eternity, so that, under your guidance, we may reach the realm of happiness and glory, there to repose eternally with you in the company of Jesus and Mary. The Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau has long been instrumental in joining with the universal Catholic Church in support of the missions. During his visit, Fr. Augustine will ask for support for Star Academy Foundation - Star High School, a co-ed school for boys and girls in Tanzania. Star High School is Fr. Augustine's lifelong dream. He opened the school in 2007 with 150 students and now there are more than 550 students.
