



Each year, in cooperation with the Missionary Cooperative Program of the Pontifical Mission Society, missionaries are welcomed from dioceses around the globe to visit parishes in an effort to educate people about work in their local Church, as well as give the opportunity to participate in their mission work by requesting the support of prayer and financial assistance in order to meet their needs. In this way, every parish has an opportunity to be part of this global work.

Next weekend, July 10 - 11, Fr. Augustine Njuu, A.J. will be a guest here at St. Vincent. Fr. Augustine is a Tanzania-born Roman Catholic Priest. He belongs to the institute of the Apostles of Jesus, a relatively young congregation founded in 1968 and the first of its kind to be erected in Africa for the express purpose of training and forming religious missionaries as Priest and Brothers for the evangelizing mission of the Church.

During his visit, Fr. Augustine will ask for support for Star Academy Foundation - Star High School, a co-ed school for boys and girls in Tanzania. Star High School is Fr. Augustine's lifelong dream. He opened the school in 2007 with 150 students and now there are more than 550 students.

St. Vincent Campus Planning - Phase 1

Just an FYI for everyone, the **second part** of Phase 1 of Campus Planning is underway. This week, Midwest Environmental Studies will remove the asbestos from the ceiling texture of the old rectory and also remove the asbestos floor tile and mastic. Once the asbestos has been removed, the old rectory will be razed. This will happen during the last week of July (approximately July 26). Once the debris has been removed and the lot cleared, new parking will be created for the Church and school.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)




