<u>Mary is Model of Persevering Silence</u> by Pope St. John Paul II gives us all an opportunity to see how we can cultivate silence in our lives. As we read these words of this great leader in the Church (from his General Audience on Wednesday, November 22, 1995), let's reflect upon how we do with the quiet in our life. This especially relates to our time in Church before and after Mass. Maybe we could teach one another, especially our young parishioners, the value of listening to God in the silence. ~ *Father Rick*

Pope St. John Paul II says:

The Blessed Virgin invites the church to meditate constantly on the mystery of Christ and she witnesses to the significance of quiet humility and loving obedience.

Our Lady's motherly smile, reproduced in so much Marian iconography, expresses a fullness of grace and peace that seeks to be shared. This expression of her serenity of spirit effectively contributes to giving the Church a joyful face.
