


The Search

Because of HIPAA laws, once you are in the hospital it is difficult to find information regarding your needs. If you are a patient in the hospital and need anointing, have a family member call the office and share your room number so that one of the priests can visit you.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)

Matrimonio: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina parroquial por lo menos con seis meses de antelación. (Si usted ha estado casado antes, una anulación del matrimonio puede necesitar ser hecha primero.)

Baptism: Your family needs to be registered in the parish for three months prior to the baptism. It is necessary to schedule baptismal preparation classes six weeks prior to your child's baptism. 
