• Take a card — on one side is a Saint, on the other is a student's name from St. Vincent de Paul School or PSR classes.



- Adopt the Saint find out about this important person in Church history. Ask the Saint's intercession for the prayers on your heart.
- Pray for the student who decorated your card and adopted the same Saint. Ask your Saint's intercession for that student.


