



Rather, it adds depth of meaning to all prayer and facilitates the movement from more active modes of prayer — verbal, mental or affective prayer — into a receptive prayer of resting in God. 

Have you been to the National Shrine of the Miraculous Medal in Perryville recently? It is a perfect place to go on a summer day! The Shrine's recently renovated Chapel and Grounds are a must see! Start your visit along a beautifully landscaped "Rosary Walk" that winds through the grounds of the Shrine. It is a beautifully shaded place for reflection, prayer, meditation, and exercise. Along the walk, you will see beautiful statues of the various Marion apparitions and other Saints. The crown jewel of the walk is the 100 year old Grotto. The Rosary Walk path concludes with a breathtaking Meditation Walk encircled by 12 life-size Marian statues hand-carved in solid marble quarried from Italy. Begin or end your visit at the beautiful St. Mary of the Barren's Church near the grounds' entrance. Invite a friend, take your family, or go alone for some nice solitude. 
