What is Totus Tuus?

Totus Tuus (Latin for *Totally Yours*) was the papal motto for Pope St. John Paul II who dedicated his life to Jesus Christ through Mary. Totus Tuus is also the name of the *fun faith filled* summer youth program for all children in elementary, middle school, and high school. The week long program here at St. Vincent is dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith through evangelization, catechesis, Christian witness, music, activities, Eucharistic worship, and more!

How is Totus Tuus Structured?

The Totus Tuus Grade School Program is designed for **children entering first through sixth grades in the upcoming school year.** The children will meet Monday, June 13, through Friday, June 17, from 9:00 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. each day. Four college age young adults and seminarians are hired and trained by the diocese to come to St. Vincent Parish as a missionary team. They will lead instruction in the faith, music, and fun activities, as well as participate in Mass and Adoration. Through their enthusiastic example of love for Jesus and the Church, the missionaries inspire the young participants to seek a closer relationship with Christ.

The same four missionaries offer an evening program for junior/senior high school youth entering the seventh through twelfth grades in the upcoming school year. These grade levels meet each night Sunday, June 12, through Thursday, June 16, from 7:00 - 9:15 p.m. The missionaries will be sharing their own witness of faith with the youth as well as leading instruction, small group discussions, prayer, fellowship, and fun. This is a great opportunity for teens to encounter older peers who are on fire for their faith!

Why Should You Send Your Children To Totus Tuus?

Totus Tuus is a Catholic summer youth program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic Faith through catechesis, evangelization, Christian witness and Eucharistic worship. The goal of Totus Tuus is to help young people grow in the understanding of, strengthen their faith in, and develop a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Youth who participate in Totus Tuus not only learn more about their Catholic faith, but

The next Vincent's Vittles meal will be on June 25 and will be hosted by Community Partnership of Southeast Missouri. Plan to attend and invite a friend!



This Week and Beyond

Called to be Prophetic

Thursday, June 23

John the Baptist can be seen as a bridge between the Old Testament and the New Testament. The Gospel for today proclaims that "He (John) will be filled with the Holy Spirit ... and he will go before him (Jesus) in spirit and power ... to prepare a people fit for the Lord." We too are called to prepare a way for Jesus by our words and our actions. We are called to be a prophetic voice calling for a just and peaceful world. *Today's readings: Isaiah 49:1-6; Psalm 139:1b-3, 13-14ab, 14c-15; Acts 13:22-26; Luke 1:57-66, 80.*

Saints Peter and Paul

Wednesday, June 29

Two men could not have been more different in their approach to ministry than Saints Peter and Paul. They disagreed upon how to spread the good news, but both possessed passion and commitment to the Gospel. Each of us has been called in our baptism to take the message of God's love, mercy, and compassion to the world. How we accomplish our common mission will be as individual as our gifts and talents. *Today's readings: Acts 12:1-11; Psalm 34:2-3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9; 2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18; Matthew 16:13-19.*

Saint Mary Magdalene

Friday, July 22

Mary Magdalene is referred to as the apostle to the apostles. While she is the first person to see Jesus after the resurrection, she only recognizes him after he says her name. With her faith awakened in the encounter, she sees Christ. At his request, she goes to the disciples and announces, "I have seen the Lord!" If we slow down, we too will hear Jesus call our name and our eyes will be opened to see him in those around us. *Today's readings: Song of Songs 3:1-4b or 2 Corinthians 5:14-17; Psalm 63:2, 3-4, 5-6, 8-9; John 20:1-2, 11-18.*

Transfiguration of the Lord

Saturday, August 6

The account of the transfiguration is proclaimed twice during the liturgical year, on the Second Sunday of Lent and on August 6, the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. Atop a mountain, Peter, John, and James witnessed an event that left them in stunned silence. First, they saw a transfigured Jesus speaking with Elijah and Moses. Then they heard a voice from the cloud say, "This is my chosen Son, listen to him." Take some time today to reflect on how you see Jesus as your king in the fullness of his majestic glory. How do you share your belief that Jesus the Lord is king, and most high over all the earth? *Daniel* 7:9-10, 13-14; *Psalm* 97:1-2, 5, 6, 9; 2 *Peter* 1:16-19; *Luke* 9:28b-36.

Solemnity of the Assumption

Monday, August 15

As Catholics we believe that Mary was full of grace. This is the angel Gabriel's greeting in the account of the Annunciation. The doctrine of the Assumption of Mary that we celebrate today proclaims that at the end of her life, full of grace, Mary was taken into heaven body and soul. Today we ask Mary to show us the way to live full of grace. *Today's readings: Revelation 11:19a, 12:1-6a, 10ab; Psalm 45:10, 11, 12, 16; 1 Corinthians 15:20-27; Luke 1:39-56.*

Saint Monica

Saturday, August 27

St. Monica is known for her perseverance in praying for her son, Augustine. Her deepest desire was for Augustine to turn to God. Today's first reading proclaims: "This is the will of God, your holiness." Monica believed this with her whole heart, and through an answer to her prayer, her son found God and holiness. Will God do any less for us when we pray? *Today's readings: 1 Corinthians 1:26-31; Psalm 33:12-13, 18-19, 20-21; Matthew 25:14-30.*

Sunday, June 5

The Power of the Spirit

Today's readings: Acts 2:1-11; Psalm 104:1, 24, 29-30, 31, 34; 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13; John:19-23. Imagine the energy that must have been in the room where the disciples had gathered to await the coming of the Holy Spirit. Anticipation may have been mixed with fear as the disciples pondered the words about the Advocate. And then the driving wind and tongues of fire settle over them all.

Compelled to leave the locked room, the disciples find themselves in the midst of a crowd from all ends of the known world. Inspired to proclaim the "mighty acts of God," they are understood in the native languages of the gathered. Filled with the Holy Spirit, the disciples are bolstered by the gift of courage. Never again will they live in fear.

This Pentecost day we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit given to us in baptism and affirmed confirmation. This Spirit is our life force as disciples. As followers of Christ, we simply need to be open and ready for all that this Spirit will do in and through us. It is the power of the Spirit that will give us the courage and wisdom to be the people God has called us to be. Through that Spirit, we bear witness that we are adopted children of God and, as St. Paul says, we can cry, "Abba, Father." As joint heirs with Christ, we live to glorify God.
