### **The Big Lie**

The issue of abortion has been in the news lately and threats have been made to Catholic churches. Old lies have been resurfaced saying that the Catholic Church only cares about the baby in the womb and once the baby is born, we don't do anything to help the mother. What a lie that is! Did you know the budget for LifeHouse Crisis Maternity Home Springfield is \$1.3 million? Did you know that the cost of construction for the new LifeHouse Crisis Maternity Home in Cape Girardeau, including fundraising costs and architectural fees, comes to a total of \$7.8 million? Once it is up and running in the later summer or fall of 2023, Catholic Charities anticipates an operating budget similar to Springfield, \$1.3 million. The Healthy Moms, Healthy Babies Program at CCSOMO has an operating budget (in Deaneries 6 and 7 of the diocese) totaling \$438,160.38. This particular program works with low-income, pregnant women while they're still in their homes, some facing eviction/homelessness. They have varying social circumstances, but typically have many challenges and barriers to overcome. These women receive comprehensive case management, maternal-child education, access to many needed services, and is a service program that has been growing for years. This is an important prevention strategy to help women avoid much of what the women at LifeHouse have already faced.

In the May 13 issue of *The Mirror*, I put the totals that the youth of our diocese have raised for various pro-life initiatives, from the womb to the tomb, during the various Lenten Youth Missions of Mercy! The youth of our diocese recently raised over \$21,667 for "Mother's House," in Hayti, Missouri, the beneficiary of the 2022 Lenten initiative. In addition, an average of \$24,000 was raised during previous Lents: Eden Village, Springfield; Birthright, Cape Girardeau; Whole Kids Outreach, Ellington; and Children's Haven, Joplin; for a total of \$126,229.51. The abortion industry perpetuates a big lie when they say the Catholic Church does nothing for mothers and babies after they are born. And how many of you donated items for Mother's House, not just this year but in years past? Don't buy the lie. The Catholic Church can be proud of how we support women in need.

**Marriage**: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)
