Does your prayer life need a "pick me up?" Try something new and something old, something calming ... Centering Prayer. Centering Prayer is a method of silent prayer that prepares you to receive the gift of contemplative prayer, prayer in which you experience God's presence within you, closer than breathing, closer than thinking, closer than consciousness itself. This method of prayer is both a relationship with God and a discipline to foster that relationship. Centering Prayer is not meant to replace other kinds of prayer. Rather, it adds depth of meaning to all prayer and facilitates the movement from more active modes of prayer — verbal, mental or affective prayer — into a receptive prayer of resting in God. Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)
