Congratulations Deacon Tony Peters! The Ministry of the Deacon

The terms "Deacon" and "Diaconate" derive from the Greek word diakonia which means "service" or "ministry." A deacon, then, is ordained by the Church for service. The Dogmatic Constitution on the Church speaks of three areas of diaconal service: Ministry of Charity, Ministry of the Word, and Ministry of Liturgy.

Ministry of Charity - The deacon is ordained to be a witness to the Gospel through a life of service. A deacon serves through his person-to-person encounters: he ministers to youth and young adults, families, the poor, the aged, the sick, prisoners, etc. His ministry may encompass a wide range of community services as well.

Ministry of the Word - The deacon proclaims the Gospel. He is an agent of evangelization, that is, of announcing the Good News of Christ in society. He also preaches at liturgical gatherings and teaches in religious education programs. The deacon may work with baptism preparation, confirmation preparation, marriage preparation and annulment procedures.

Ministry of Liturgy - The deacon assists at the Eucharistic Celebration, administers Baptism, witnesses (celebrates) Marriages, officiates at wake and graveside services, administers sacramentals, presides at prayer services, e.g. Communion services and Benediction. The Liturgical vestments the deacon wears are a stole and dalmatic.

There are many ministries that are a part of a deacon's life. St. Vincent de Paul Parish is gifted to have a newly ordained deacon, Rev. Mr. Robert Anthony (Tony) Peters, who will be of service to the parish and the needs of the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau.

Members of St. Vincent are also asked to pray for the youth of the parish. You might pick a certain time of day and set a reminder to say a quick prayer.


