The Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau has long been instrumental in joining with the universal Catholic Church in support of the missions. Each year, in cooperation with the Missionary Cooperative Program of the Pontifical Mission Society, missionaries are welcomed from dioceses around the globe to visit parishes in an effort to educate people about work in their local Church, as well as give the opportunity to participate in their mission work by requesting the support of prayer and financial assistance in order to meet their needs. In this way, every parish has an opportunity to be part of this global work.

This weekend, July 1-2, Reverend Gilbert Walker, C.M. will speak at all Masses regarding the Kenya Mission of the Vincentians. The Vincentians follow Jesus Christ, evangelizing the poor, in the Spirit of their founder, St. Vincent de Paul. In Kenya, the Vincentian Fathers and Brothers educate and form priests, run a Woodworking program to train Kenyans with skills to support their families, and shepherd five parishes with 30 outstations bringing the sacraments to 40,000 people each week. They also help families and children with clean water, food, and medical care through several outreach centers. 4.2 million people in Kenya are suffering from the devastating consequences of Kenya's longest drought in years. Vincentian priests and brothers are providing food, water and supplies to those most in need.

Your gift will help form future priests in Kenya and will assist with the expansion of classrooms, a library and chapel, and a security fence at the new Novitiate to protect the facility against the growing insecurity around the area.

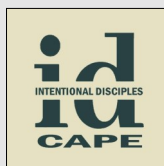
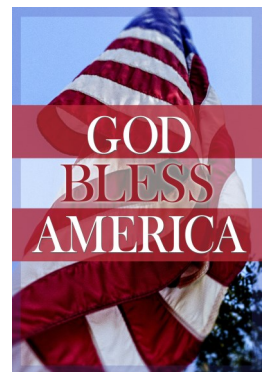
