Welcome to Wednesday PSR

Parish School of Religion (PSR) will begin on Wednesday, September 20. Classes for Grades 1 - 8 will be held in the school building and the doors will open at 5:45 p.m. Parents are asked to meet their children in their classrooms at 7:30 p.m. Parents will need to sign their student in and out at every class. This is for **all** grades.

Registration forms may be found in the gathering area of church. Please complete the form and bring it to the first class. Students must have completed registration forms before they may attend class.

Preparation for First Communion is a two-year program. The first year is an introduction to the faith. The second year prepares the child for First Reconciliation and First Communion. Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation begins with a review of all the sacraments in Grade 7. Grade 8 is when the child prepares for Confirmation.

La Escuela Parroquial de Religión, **PSR (Parish School of Religion)** comenzará clases este miércoles **20 de septiembre**. Las clases están dirigidas para los alumnos de primer a octavo grado y se darán en la escuela San Vicente de Paul, que está frente a la Iglesia. Las puertas de la escuela se abrirán a las 6:00 pm. Se iniciará con una oración a las 6:10 pm y luego los estudiantes irán a sus respectivos salones. Se les pide a los padres de familia estar a las 7:30 pm en el salón de sus hijos e hijas para recogerlos.

La preparación para la Primera Comunión es un programa de dos años. El primer año de preparación es una introducción a la fe. El segundo año prepara a los niños y niñas para realizar por primera vez el sacramento de Reconciliación y recibir su Primera Comunión. La preparación para el Sacramento de la confirmación inicia en el grado Séptimo con una revisión de todos los sacramentos, y sigue en el grado octavo donde se preparan para recibir su Confirmación.

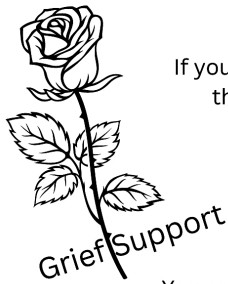
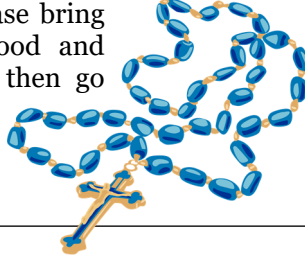

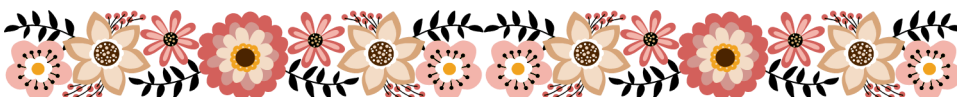
