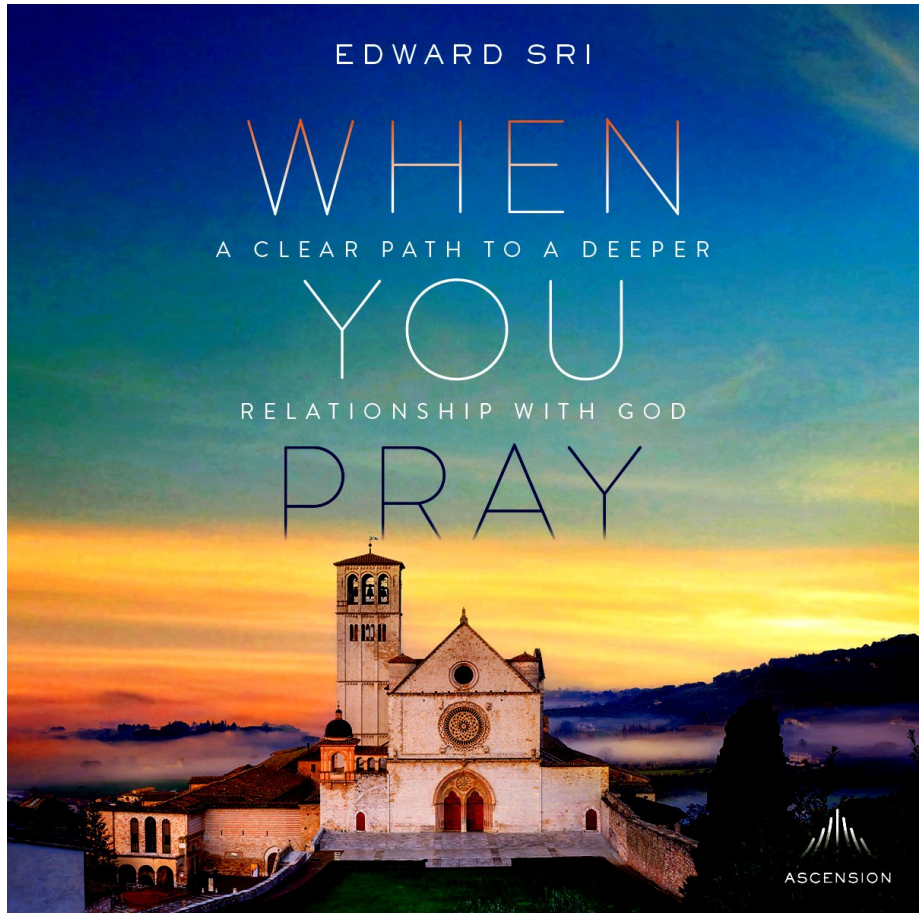
New Session:
