## **Baptismal Prep**



- 4. Reserve Your Tax Credit Amount by December 31, 2024. You will receive an Email from the Missouri State Treasurer's office. Print and save your confirmation number. You will receive a 100% tax credit for 50% of your tax obligation.
- 5. Write a check to The Bright Futures Fund for the amount of tax credits reserved. Mail your check by December 31, 2024, to: Bright Futures Fund, PO Box 419037, Kansas City, MO 64141. After verification from the state, you will receive an Email receipt. Include the receipt and a MO-TC form with your state income tax filing. (For the current MO-TC form, visit the Bright Futures Fund Website or search MO-TC at <u>https://dor.mo.gov/forms/</u>).
