The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ June 2, 2024

A Corpus Christi Primer

The Feast of Corpus Christi originated in Belgium in 1246 in response to visions in which Christ asked St. Juliana of Mont-Cornillon to champion a feast to honor the Eucharist. St. Juliana was initially reluctant to share and act on the visions and, once she did share, it took several years for the feast day to spread. In 1264, Pope Urban IV instituted the Feast of Corpus Christi for the entire Church as a way to honor the Eucharist in a most special way. Today the Feast of Corpus Christi is celebrated around the world, most notably in Eucharistic Processions. In many countries, the feast is designated a national holiday and is celebrated the Thursday after the octave of Pentecost; many countries celebrate it on the Sunday following Trinity Sunday. In some countries the procession route is marked by artistic creations made from flowers or colored sawdust.

Today after the 9:00 a.m. Mass, there will be a Eucharistic Procession on the church grounds. All are invited to join in. At the end of the procession and prior to the 10:45 a.m. Mass, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for prayer


