## Diocesan Development Fund Update *Goal Reached!*

The Bishop's Annual Appeal, the Diocesan Development Fund Campaign (DDF) is the annual campaign for the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau. The funds raised advance the diocese's mission through ministries that assist families, parishes, and the diocese as a whole. DDF is vital to the life of the Church in southern Missouri.

To date St. Vincent parishioners have given \$313,350 toward the financial goal of \$285,000 (109.9%). As for the donor goal of 600 families, there have been 501 families who have made a pledge (83.5%). Thank you! Across the diocese, as of June 20, 2024, \$2,120,667 has been pledged toward the \$2,950,000 goal (72%). The donor total is 4,761 out of 7,500 (63%).



**Care Portal Update**

**Fiscal Year July 2023 - June 2024**

St. Vincent de Paul Parish volunteers have been busy responding to very special Care Portal needs. You may remember that a child is always at the center of these needs. The goal of Care Portal is to assist families in poverty who are either working to keep their children in their homes or those who are fostering children.

The following is an update on how families have been helped in the community during the past fiscal year. Several mothers who needed car repairs have been helped. Having the repairs covered was a huge relief and allowed the mothers to quickly return to work and keep important appointments. Utility and rental assistance was offered to a family who was working hard but fell behind. Several dressers were purchased and delivered to families helping them stay organized. A bike was purchased for an individual who graduated from foster care. This was his only means of transportation to work. Clothing was purchased for a teen in foster care who had only a few items of clothing. These are just a few examples of how Care Portal served families who were working hard but still in need.

St. Vincent de Paul Parish has a special collection specifically for Care Portal every year on the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God (New Year's Day). Thank you to those who have donated to this special program or who have helped fill requests during this past fiscal year. Please continue to pray for all Care Portal families.



## Update from Seminarian Daniel Dunn

*This is an update from Seminarian Daniel Dunn who is at IPF (Institute for Priestly Formation). Daniel arrived at Creighton University on May 26 and will be there until August 1. The following is his synopsis of what has been going on ...*

It's been an interesting time so far at IPF. During the first week, we had a class on "Discernment of Spirits." We also learned how to determine the difference between the work of the Holy Spirit, the work of the Enemy (Devil), and our own work. We had a lecture introducing us to St. Ignatius's rules on the Discernment of Spirits. Through these experiences I learned how I was supposed to spend a Holy Hour in contemplation and prayer. We then had a week of silent retreat. This included four Holy Hours per day, Mass, Liturgy of the Hours, and an evening gathering. The Holy Hours were to be spent while on walks or in chapels around campus and other places. This experience allowed me to experience the grace and holiness of God wherever I went. It also allowed me to work on being contemplative even while in motion on a walk. I am grateful that Bishop Rice has sent me here to IPF in Omaha.
