

Update on Feasibility Study

The result of the feasibility study which assessed the interest and opinion of St. Vincent parishioners for the three-fold purpose of:

- 1. rehab of the DePaul Center (Old Notre Dame High School) into a Parish Center;
- 2. reclamation of rooms for additional classrooms in the school along with roof replacement of the old school section; and
- 3. increasing the Gathering Space of Church, including the remodeling of the Church Sanctuary.

I am now collaborating with parish leadership in processing the report given by Gretchen Gambon who helped with the feasibility study. In a few weeks I should be able to provide the full analysis of what the results of the study were. I can say this, the feasibility study was positive and encouraging. Once again, thank you to everyone who took part in the survey. I look forward to sharing more information as we move forward with recommendations from parish leadership. Please hold up this process in your prayers to the Holy Spirit, St. Joseph and St. Vincent for wisdom and guidance. We rely on the help of God!

VIRTUS Update

On July 1, the Diocese changed to a different company for recording the Background Screening information needed for VIRTUS. This personal information could not be easily transferred from the previous background screening company. All employees and volunteers with active VIRTUS accounts must complete these steps:

- Log into your VIRTUS account at <u>www.virtus.org</u> and follow the prompts on the screen to complete the new Background Screening.
- The Background Consent form <u>and</u> the 2024-2025 Code of Conduct are accessible through your VIRTUS account (top left margin). Please print the two forms and sign by hand (not computer generated) and submit them to Beverly in the parish office or email <u>bmcmeel@svparish.com</u>.

The background screenings conducted by the Diocesan Office of Child and Youth Protection have never and will never include financial information or credit reports. The background screenings are only to verify identity and to gather criminal background information

Celebrating the Sacraments Celebrando los Sacramentos

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)

Matrimonio: Por favor comuníquese con la oficina parroquial por lo menos con **seis meses** de antelación. (Si usted ha estado casado antes, una anulación del matrimonio puede necesitar ser hecha primero.)

Baptism: Your family needs to be registered in the parish for three months prior to the baptism. It is necessary to schedule baptismal preparation classes six weeks prior to your child's baptism. Taking the baptism class prior to birth is encouraged! Contact the parish office at 573-335-7667.

Missouri's K-12 Scholarship Program

Many families may be eligible for a full scholarship to attend St. Vincent de Paul Grade School through the MOScholars program. Students must be entering either kindergarten or first grade or be a new transfer student from public school. Students with IEP's are also eligible. Income eligibility is no more than 200% of the Free and Reduced lunch guidelines. This is \$111,000 for a family of four. Go to <u>brightfuturesfund.org</u> and click on "Springfield, Joplin and Cape Girardeau Schools Prequalification Application 2024-2005 School Year" to see if you qualify.
