


#### "This is our God" Concert and Guest Speaker



## **Celebrating the Sacraments Celebrando los Sacramentos**

**Marriage:** Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)

#### **Update on Feasibility Study**

The result of the feasibility study which assessed the interest and opinion of St. Vincent parishioners for the three-fold purpose of:

- rehab of the DePaul Center (Old Notre Dame High School) into a Parish Center;
- 2. reclamation of rooms for additional classrooms in the school along with roof replacement of the old school section; and
- 3. increasing the Gathering Space of Church, including the remodeling of the Church Sanctuary.

I am now collaborating with parish leadership in processing the report given by Gretchen Gambon who helped with the feasibility study. #### **MOScholars Tax Credits**

Did you know you can direct up to half of your annual state income taxes to be used for scholarships for children to attend Catholic schools – all at no cost to you? When you write a check to the *Bright Futures Fund* of the MOScholars Scholarship Program for the amount of your reserved tax credits, you help fund scholarships for children to attend Catholic schools in the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau, many of whom may not have been otherwise able to attend. You are diverting your tax dollars *you already owe* to the state to help students have **BRIGHT FUTURES!** Follow these easy steps:

- 1. Go to The Bright Futures Fund Website at <a href="https://www.brightfuturesfund.org">https://www.brightfuturesfund.org</a> and click "Reserve Your Tax Credits Here."
- 2. Estimate Your Tax Liability based on what you paid last year. Fill out all fields for the MOScholars Tax Credit Reservation System.
- 3. Choose Bright Futures Fund from the EAO (Educational Assistance Organization) drop down menu.
- 4. Reserve Your Tax Credit Amount by December 31, 2024. You will receive an Email from the Missouri State Treasurer's office. Print and save your confirmation number. You will receive a 100% tax credit for 50% of your tax obligation.
- 5. Write a check to The Bright Futures Fund for the amount of tax credits reserved. Mail your check by December 31, 2024, to: Bright Futures Fund, PO Box 419037, Kansas City, MO 64141. After verification from the state, you will receive an Email receipt. Include the receipt and a MO-TC form with your state income tax filing. (For the current MO-TC form, visit the Bright Futures Fund Website or search MO-TC at <a href="https://dor.mo.gov/forms/">https://dor.mo.gov/forms/</a>).

#### **VIRTUS Update**

On July 1, the Diocese changed to a different company for recording the Background Screening information needed for VIRTUS. This personal information could not be easily transferred from the previous background screening company. All employees and volunteers with active VIRTUS accounts must complete these steps:

- Log into your VIRTUS account at <u>www.virtus.org</u> and follow the prompts on the screen to complete the new Background Screening.
- The Background Consent form <u>and</u> the 2024-2025 Code of Conduct are accessible through your VIRTUS account (top left margin). Please print the two forms and sign by hand (not computer generated) and submit them to Beverly in the parish office or email bmcmeel@svparish.com.

The background screenings conducted by the Diocesan Office of Child and Youth Protection have never and will never include financial information or credit reports. The background screenings are only to verify identity and to gather criminal background information
