# Welcome to Wednesday PSR



### Marian Consecration

I am excited to announce an opportunity to consecrate ourselves and our parish to Our Most Blessed Mother. There is an urgent need for heaven to intercede in the life of our families, the Church, and our world, and for us to place ourselves under the care and direction of the Blessed Mother by consecrating our lives to Her. Our communal intentions for this consecration will be for a spiritual revitalization in our country, for the protection of all life from conception to natural death, and for the healing of Hudson Reinagel as we consecrate him to our Blessed Mother.

For those who are new to consecrations, you may be asking yourself what is a Marian Consecration? What does it mean? The Gospel of John 19:26-27 says, When Jesus saw his mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to her, "Woman, here is your son," and to the disciple, "Here is your mother." From that time on, this disciple took her into his home. A Marian Consecration is the gift Jesus gives to us from the Cross, of His own Mother as our Mother. He invites us to accept Mary into our own hearts as our Mother and bring Her into our own homes. That we share with Her our own joys, hopes, sorrows, fears, and that we walk with Mary who is always leading us to Jesus. Through consecration to Mary you are saying, "Yes, Jesus I accept this gift that you give to me of Mary as my spiritual Mother." I receive Her, I love her, and I allow Her to form me in holiness just as She formed You.

The program we will be using is Mary's Mantle Consecration: A Spiritual Retreat for Heaven's Help. This retreat is an amazing and unique program that has resulted in miracles in the lives and hearts of its participants and their loved ones.

Our consecration will begin on October 24 and will conclude on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, on December 8. The consecration consists of a daily rosary, daily two-minute readings, optional journal writing, daily reflections, a weekly video, and simple fasting. # Please Vote "No"

Amendment 3, which will appear on Missouri's November 2024 ballot, is an extreme constitutional amendment that legalizes abortion at any stage of pregnancy with no protections for the preborn child, even when the child is capable of feeling pain. The amendment would effectively repeal long-standing health and safety standards for women. These include basic health and safety requirements for clinics where abortions are performed, requiring that abortions be performed only by a physician, informed consent requirements, laws prohibiting public funding of abortion, and parental consent requirements before a minor's abortion.

All Missourians are urged to stand for the health and safety of women and their preborn children and oppose Amendment 3. Please pray that the Missouri Pro-Abortion Ballot Initiative is defeated.

Dear Gracious God, by your hand we received the gift of life at the moment of conception. Through the working of the Holy Spirit, you call us to live out our faith even in the midst of a troubled world. You call us to proclaim the truth of the Gospel of Life and your love to all around us.

We ask you to bless us as we share your teachings on the dignity of all human life, especially the preborn and their mothers. Give us strength of heart and mind. Do not allow us to be discouraged as we make our voices heard to proclaim your teachings that are now being threatened.

Give us a clear voice as we work to overcome the trial before us for the sake of all people in Missouri. We ask this in the name of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Dear Parishioner of St. Vincent de Paul Parish,

It's hard to believe the Summer is coming to an end and that Autumn, the opening of a new school year, and the return to regular schedules are upon us. As we embark on these new beginnings, I want to update you on our exciting plans for a Capital Campaign here at St. Vincent de Paul to support our parish's growth and development.

As you may recall, our Parish commissioned a study to assess a potential Capital Campaign in support of these efforts:

- Expand the Gathering Space in front of the Church to enhance community.
- Reconfigure our Church entrance and access points for greater ease of entry.
- Remodel our Sanctuary for greater reverence and spirituality.
- Modernize amenities for comfort and energy efficiency.
- Increase meeting room space for faith formation groups and activities.
- Optimize the De Paul Center (the former Notre Dame High School building) for:
  - A multi-purpose center and kitchen for social gatherings, weddings, and Fish Fries.
  - Dedicated space for service organizations.
  - New space for our Parish Offices.
  - More productive space for school use.
  - Dedicated space for our Parish Youth Ministry.
- Repurpose freed up space in our parish grade school, now shared for parish events, to better serve the needs of our school children, thereby creating a more secure school building. Also replace the roof on the school building's older section.

With Bishop Rice's approval, the Parish has engaged Dille Pollard Architecture to study the costs of these initiatives. We have begun to gather architectural drawings and cost estimates. Additionally, we have contracted Mrs. Gretchen Gambon, a seasoned parish campaign professional from Springfield, Missouri, to act as a guide through this important process.

In May and June, Mrs. Gambon led the Feasibility Study, which included 160 interviews with individuals and couples both in-person and via an online survey. I am very grateful to those who graciously took part in this process. The primary goals were to assess the feasibility of a campaign, gather parishioners' perceptions about our parish and a campaign, and evaluate support for and cost of these projects, while uncovering opportunities and challenges.

As promised to you a few weeks ago, the major findings of the study are as follows:

- The parish received good and above-standard responses/support in most areas of the study.
- St. Vincent de Paul is perceived as a caring, friendly, faith-filled, active, and generous parish.
- Both personal interviewees and online survey participants believe the parish is meeting their spiritual needs. In fact, these responses are well above the norm.
- People feel strongly and are committed to St. Vincent de Paul Parish and their fellow parishioners.
- Participants in the study-process rated communications as very good.
- The project has strong support; however, parishioners would like our needs prioritized and more details about the proposed uses of a new Parish Hall/Center. They also would like additional information on the proposed renovations to the Gathering Space and Sanctuary.
- Support exists for launching a campaign and moving forward with the projects.

These findings are both positive and encouraging. We have already begun implementing the seventeen core recommendations identified in the study, and we continue to make significant progress toward our goals.

I would like to offer my heartfelt thanks to our campaign volunteers and to all of you for keeping an open mind as we consider the future of our parish facilities. Mrs. Gambon met with campaign volunteers earlier this month, and progress continues. Please know that our actions are and will continue to be the result of a tremendous amount of thought, prayerful discernment, and planning based on the data we have gathered and the goals we will work toward to keep our parish relevant, vital, and of maximum service to our parishioners.

My hope, prayer, and request are that everyone in our parish community be clear on our plans for readying our parish campus for the next 50 years of spiritual, educational, and communal development. This is an opportunity for every family to be involved in our parish community and spiritual life for the future of our parish.

This is a vital time for our parish, and a proud moment for me as your Pastor. I am excited to be sharing this journey with all of you. As we move into the fall months, please know I will continue to provide regular updates on this important process. Your continued involvement, prayers, and support are critical as we work together to envision the future of St. Vincent de Paul Parish. If you have any questions or would like to get involved, please do not hesitate to reach out.

You have my love, appreciation, and prayers as we continue to envision the hope-filled future of St. Vincent de Paul Parish.
