## USCCB Respect Life Novena

Most Reverend Michael F. Burbidge, Bishop of Arlington and Chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities, issued a statement inviting Catholics to commemorate October's Respect Life Month by embracing this moment of Eucharistic Revival to direct and strengthen efforts to defend human life.

The USCCB Secretariat of Pro-Life Activities recommends the Respect Life Novena to be prayed annually **October 22-30**, but it can be prayed at any time. This novena prays for the protection of human life, from conception to natural death. Each day of the novena features a different prayer intention, as well as a short reflection, suggested actions, and additional information to help participants go deeper.

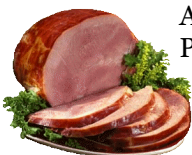

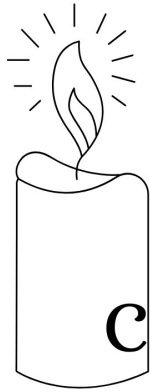
## Maxine's Shareable Wearables

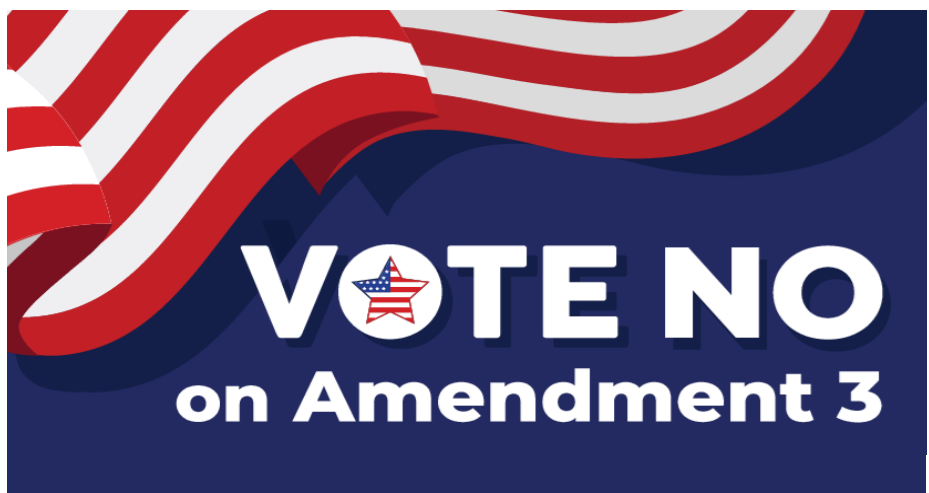
