- **Pray for the student** who decorated your card and adopted the same Saint. Ask your Saint's intercession for that student. Pray for your student through the month of November and beyond.




Day of Prayer and Fasting



If your school isn't attending the Bishop's Mass, or your child goes to a non-Catholic school, you and your eighth graders are more than welcome to attend!


