This is the first step. God will probably point you to the person He has in mind. God may be opening the doors for the conversation to begin. It is all about trusting in God. Trust!

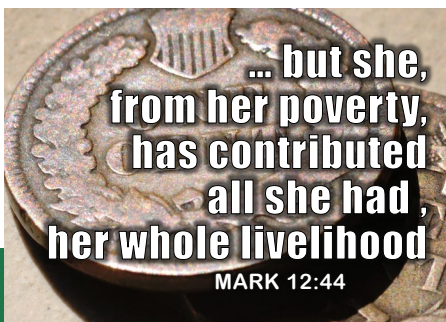

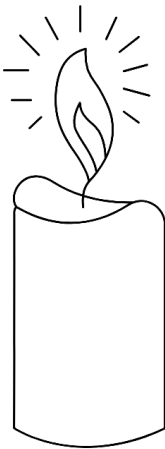

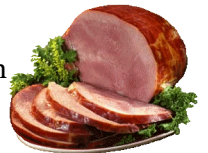
We host monthly DTS meetings right here at St. Vincent.
