He professed his final vows in May 2014 and was ordained to the priesthood on December 1, 2016. He is a devoted Priest and Monk who is committed to spiritual leadership, community enrichment, and pastoral care.

Father Vineesh has a strong passion for sports and championed the team representing the State of Kerala for the first time at the Indian National Dodgeball Championship.

Father Vineesh received his BA in Philosophy from St. Joseph's Pontifical Seminary in Aluva, India, in 2012, followed by his BA in Theology from Kristu Joyti College in Bangalore, India, in 2016. He also holds a Master's Degree in Physical Education and a Doctorate in Philosophy in Physical Education.

Bishop Rice's plan is for Father Vineesh to be trained to be a Pastor by July 1, 2025!
