- Remove all non-school activity from the Parish Grade School, to create a dedicated, safe and secure environment for education.

## Baptismal Prep

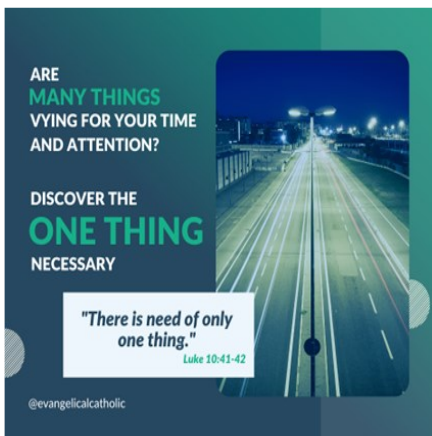
