There’s little to no closeness;
no slow, wasteful time together; no intimacy.

And there’s only one way to get out of roommate mode and become more connected;
It is to spend more time doing the following:

That’s it, there’s no other cure for “roommate mode” than time and communication.

We need to look one another in the eyes, talk, and listen.

“How was your day?”

“How did that event go you were nervous about?”

“Thank you for taking care of that, I really appreciate it.”

“How are you doing? Really?”

The 1% Challenge is an invitation to get out of roommate mode with God.

Don’t stop doing good things to serve God through your vocation.

But build in some regular “sit down, talk, and listen” time each day.

Slow down for 15 minutes, look the Lord in the eye, and talk and listen
