# What are the changes to the Church Worship Space and Sanctuary?

An essential element of the updated sanctuary is to appreciate and celebrate the Sacraments of the Church that are central to the Catholic faith.

These updates will provide an atmosphere for worship, prayer, and celebration in the place where God meets us every day to give us the gift of Himself and we say thank you through Mass, adoration, and the sacraments.

Components have been incorporated in the sanctuary updates that will be noble and simple; designed to call people to God's glory. A Baldacchino (canopy) with stained glass will draw attention to the altar where the Sacrifice of the Mass occurs and where the Holy Eucharist is reserved in the tabernacle. A side Chapel in honor of the Miraculous Medal will honor the Vincentian priests and brothers who sacrificed much for evangelization. Vincentian statuary will also be incorporated to honor our Vincentian roots and history.

The enhanced sanctuary addresses our inherent desire for something of beauty that speaks to the sacred Truth of our Eucharistic Liturgy, the Mass, and to the sacramental and prayer life.

# **Guidelines for Fasting/Abstinence during Lent**

**Abstinence** is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. **Fasting** is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for ages 18 - 59 (inclusive). The Church defines fasting as one meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal, as well as no eating between meals.

*Note:* If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial suitable to their condition.



# Stations of the Cross - A Beautiful Tradition

The Stations of the Cross are images of stories about the passion and death of Jesus Christ. Most of the stories which make up the Stations were drawn from Scripture, and others, such as Saint Veronica wiping the face of Jesus, were taken from tradition. The route traditionally held to have been taken by Jesus to his death at Calvary (Golgotha) in Jerusalem is called the Via Dolorosa or the Sorrowful Way. The Stations were erected in local churches as a way of bringing this prayerful experience to those who could not travel to Jerusalem.

Stations of the Cross are celebrated in the church every Friday during Lent at 5:00 in Spanish and at 6:15 p.m. in English. Stations are also celebrated by the school children on some Wednesday afternoons at 2:00 p.m. Please join in this devotional prayer and make it a part of your Lenten journey.


