Prayer for Deacons

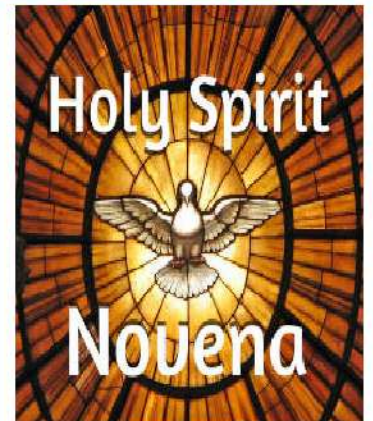
