Special Collection for Gaza - Next Weekend

Pope Leo XIV and Catholic ambassadors around the world have highlighted with great concern the unfolding humanitarian crisis and mass starvation in Gaza, with the Pope calling the situation "dire."

Bishop Rice and other U.S. bishops are asking parishioners to participate in a second collection for emergency humanitarian aid for the starving people of Gaza, a crisis that has reached catastrophic levels. There is terrible suffering of Christians and other innocent victims of violence who are struggling to survive, to protect their children, and to live humanely in tragic circumstances.

All funds from this collection will be used by *Catholic Relief Services*, which is on site in Gaza and partnering with local Church entities to provide food, shelter, financial assistance, hygiene supplies, and trauma assistance; and the *Catholic Near East Welfare Association*, which is providing "vital emergency humanitarian relief and medical care for the sick, malnourished, and wounded."

This second collection supporting the people of Gaza will be taken up at all Masses next weekend, September 6 - 7. Please be generous.

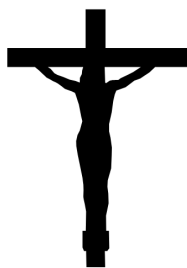

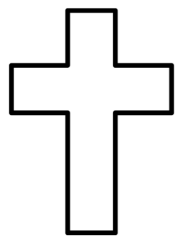

Welcome to PSR Parish School of Religion Grades 1-8

Welcome to Wednesday **PSR** (Parish School of Religion). Class for the 2025-2026 school year will begin on **Wednesday, September 17**, and will continue through May, 2026. This program is designed to assist students and their families in the religious education of children attending public schools and homeschooled students.

Classes for Grades 1 - 8 will be held in the school building. Doors will open at 5:45 p.m. Parents are asked to meet their children in their classrooms at 7:30 p.m. Parents will need to sign their student in and out at every class. This is for all grades.

Registration forms may be found in the gathering area of the church. Please complete the form and bring it to the first class. Students must have completed registration forms before they may attend class. Our first class will be Wednesday, September 17, 2025. The first class will begin in church for a short prayer time and then conclude in the school building.

Sacrament Preparation - Preparation for First Communion is a two-year program. The first year is an introduction to the faith. The second year prepares the child for First Reconciliation and First Communion.

Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation begins with a review of all sacraments in Grade 7. The child prepares for Confirmation in Grade 8.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)

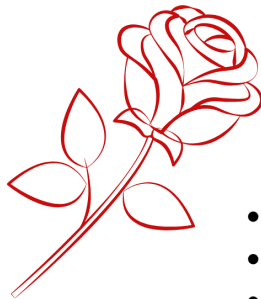

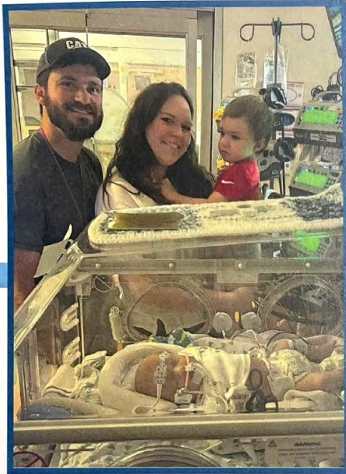
