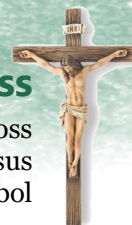
The Exaltation of the Cross September 14, 2025

Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

On this day, the church commemorates the finding of the True Cross of Christ by St. Helena in 326 AD. The focus of this feast is how Jesus transformed an instrument of torture and humiliation into a symbol of love, salvation and triumph.

Do you have a crucifix in a prominent place in your domestic church — your home? The presence of the cross is a reminder of His love, as well as saying boldly that your family belongs to Jesus Christ. It should be the heartbeat of your home where you find strength, love and peace. When you return your blessed cross to its proper place in your home, say a prayer of thanksgiving for the sacrifice of Jesus Christ, kiss the cross, and re-consecrate your home to Him — the source of all blessings.

As a result, there has been a dramatic rise in Christian emigration from the Holy Land and less than 1% of the population is Christian.

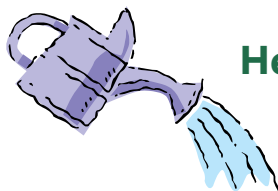

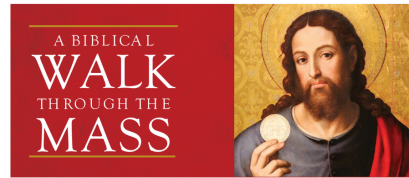

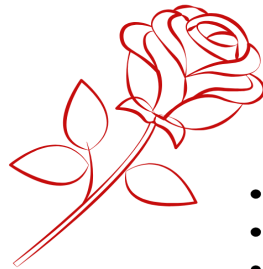

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)

Welcome to Parish School of Religion Grades 1-8

Welcome to Wednesday **PSR** (Parish School of Religion). Class for the 2025-2026 school year will begin on **Wednesday, September 17**, and will continue through May, 2026. This program is designed to assist students and their families in the religious education of children attending public schools and homeschooled students.

Classes for Grades 1 - 8 will be held in the school building. Doors will open at 5:45 p.m. Parents are asked to meet their children in their classrooms at 7:30 p.m. Parents will need to sign all students in and out at every class.

Registration forms may be found in the gathering area of the church. Please complete the form and bring it to the first class. Students must have completed registration forms before they may attend class. Our first class will be Wednesday, September 17, 2025. The first class will begin in church for a short prayer time and then conclude in the school building.

Sacrament Preparation - Preparation for First Communion is a two-year program. The first year is an introduction to the faith. The second year prepares the child for First Reconciliation and First Communion.

Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation begins with a review of all sacraments in Grade 7. The child prepares for Confirmation in Grade 8.
