Update on the Cape Girardeau Warming Center

The Cape Warming Center has been up and running since late November at Grace United Methodist Church. The Warming Center has been serving approximately 20 people each night, both men and women. Although running smoothly, there is a desperate need for volunteers to help. Area churches are being asked to consider volunteering support for a week at a time. St. Vincent de Paul Parish hopes to fill all shifts the weeks of January 4 - 10 and February 1 - 7. This would be an opportunity to support the vulnerable in the local community and to help ease the burden for the volunteers on the committee who have been taking shifts on a regular basis.

The shift times are 7:00 - 11:00 p.m., 11:00 p.m. - 3:00 a.m., and 3:00 - 7:00 a.m. On every shift there is a male volunteer as well as a volunteer core leader who will train you. The Cape Girardeau police department patrols the area frequently throughout the night.

The Warming Center is only open if the nighttime low is 26 degrees or below or 32 degrees and below with precipitation. In the event the weather does not meet these criteria, the Warming Center will not be open. You can call 573-222-0914 and listen to the voicemail to see if the Warming Center will be open each night. Christmas Gifts for Birthright

If you wish to share with a Birthright baby during this Christmas season, gifts will be collected in the gathering area at all Christmas Masses. Most items collected will be used in layettes given to mothers just before their babies are born. Items needed include **new:** heavy sleepers (sizes newborn and o-3 months), onesies (sizes newborn and o-3 months), winter outfits (sizes newborn and o-3 months), socks (newborn), baby wipes, baby wash and lotion, baby bottles (4 and 8 oz.) and brushes, Similac Advanced formula, baby hygiene items, small board books, small stuffed animals, teething toys, pacifiers, diaper bags, breastfeeding supplies, feminine hygiene pads. Needed items also include **new and gently used:** baby fleece and receiving blankets, baby quilts, mittens, socks, bibs, burp cloths, hooded towels, washcloths, toddler clothing (2T-3T), shoes, boots, coats, and toddler socks.
