20 + C + M + B + 26

Continue the tradition...

Bless your home - chalk your doors

Pick up an Epiphany House Blessing kit
after Mass on January 3 or January 4

What does 20+C+M+B+26 mean? And why do we chalk this formula above our doorways? The letters represent the initials of the Magi: Caspar, Malchior, and Balthazar who visited Jesus in His first home. They also abbreviate the Latin "Christus mansionem benedicat": "May Christ bless the house". The + signs represent the cross, and the "20" and "26" mark the beginning and end of the year. We dedicate our year to God asking His blessing on our homes and on all who live, work, or visit there. Seeing the symbols over our door can be a reminder, while passing in and out, that our homes and all those who dwell there belong to Christ.

Cape Girardeau Warming Center News

Since late November the Cape Girardeau Warming Center has been available at Grace United Methodist Church and has been serving approximately 20 men and women each night. Although running smoothly, there is a desperate need for volunteers to help. Area churches are being asked to consider volunteering support for a week at a time. **St. Vincent de Paul Parish hopes to fill all shifts the weeks of January 4 - 10 and February 1 - 7.** This would be an opportunity to support the vulnerable in the local community and to help ease the burden for the volunteers on the committee who have been taking shifts on a regular basis.

The shift times are 7:00 - 11:00 p.m., 11:00 p.m. - 3:00 a.m., and 3:00 - 7:00 a.m. On every shift there is a male volunteer as well as a volunteer core leader who will train you. The Cape Girardeau police department patrols the area frequently throughout the night.

The Warming Center is only open if the nighttime low is 26 degrees or below or 32 degrees and below with precipitation. In the event the weather does not meet these criteria, the Warming Center will not be open. You can call 573-222-0914 and listen to the voicemail to see if the Warming Center will be open each night.
