As winter approaches, the **Cape Warming Center** is committed to providing a safe and warm place for those in need during periods of extreme cold. To ensure the safety and well-being of the community, the Center will open its doors under the following weather conditions: **when temperatures reach 32°F or below** *with* **precipitation**, or **when temperatures drop to 27°F or below** *without* **precipitation**.

When these conditions occur, the Warming Center will open at Grace United Methodist/Compass Church to offer a warm, dry, and safe environment for individuals seeking shelter from the winter weather.
