



**regarding demolition and construction of
the St. Vincent de Paul Parish Family Center!**

The Parish Construction Team (PCT), consisting of Father Rick Jones, Brad Burdick, Rick Essner, Bob Janota, and Tom Reinagel, along with Dillie Pollard Architects and Diocesan representatives, have chosen a construction company from the four that were interviewed (Sides Construction from Jackson, Boulder and Columbia Construction from Cape Girardeau, and Zoellner Construction from Perryville). Sides Construction has been chosen to do the interior demolition of the Parish Family Center and then to begin the construction rehab. Look for work to begin on the Parish Family Center at the end of February. Keep praying for the Capital Campaign as we move forward as a Parish Community.

Reconciliation During Lent

“Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel!” These are the words heard on Ash Wednesday when ashes are marked on each person’s forehead. During these days of Lent, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered at various times. Take advantage of these blessed encounters with the Forgiving Father!

- Every Friday from 6:45 - 7:15 p.m.
- Every Saturday from 3:30 - 4:30 p.m.

You may also make an appointment if these times are not good for you.

Guidelines for Fasting/Abstinence during Lent

Abstinence is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. **Fasting** is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for ages 18 - 59 (inclusive). The Church defines fasting as one meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal, as well as no eating between meals.


Note: If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial suitable to their condition.

Stations of the Cross - A Beautiful Tradition

The Stations of the Cross are images of stories about the passion and death of Jesus Christ. Most of the stories which make up the Stations were drawn from Scripture, and others, such as Saint Veronica wiping the face of Jesus, were taken from tradition. The route traditionally held to have been taken by Jesus to his death at Calvary (Golgotha) in Jerusalem is called the Via Dolorosa or the Sorrowful Way. The Stations were erected in local churches as a way of bringing this prayerful experience to those who could not travel to Jerusalem.



Stations of the Cross are celebrated in the church every Friday during Lent at 5:00 in Spanish and at 6:15 p.m. in English. Please join in this devotional prayer and make it a part of your Lenten journey.
