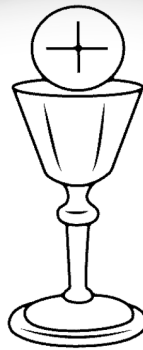

**Translation of letter
from the Poor Clare
Missionary Sisters ...**

Dear Easter People of St. Vincent de Paul Parish,

I wish all of you a Happy Easter!

During this Lenten Season, a prayer of mine has been answered. Since I began my pastorate here in 2017, I thought that it would be a wonderful gift to have religious Sisters in the parish. I have been praying for this since October 22, 2020. It was at that time that I began conversation with the Regional Superior of the Poor Clare Missionary Sisters, Sister Rocio Alcantar, MC. The Poor Clares' Motherhouse is in Santa Ana, California. At that time I knew a few of the Poor Clare Missionary Sisters who were assigned to Poplar Bluff. I asked Sister Rocio to consider the possibility of starting a new Poor Clare Missionary apostolate in Cape Girardeau at St. Vincent de Paul Parish.

Time went by and the Sisters elected a new Regional Superior. I continued the discussion with the new Regional Superior, Sister Yanory Zuñiga, MC. With Sister Yanory I discussed how St. Vincent de Paul Parish could be a central location for ministry for the Sisters. The work of the Sisters could take place at not only St. Vincent de Paul Parish, but also at any of the other seven parishes within a 20-mile radius of Cape Girardeau. During this time Bishop Rice was well aware of my efforts with the Poor Clare Missionary Sisters.

Mother Martha Hernandez, the General Superior of the Poor Clare Missionary Sisters in Rome, has given her blessing for the Poor Clares to begin a new apostolate here at St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church in Cape Girardeau. Bishop Rice has given his blessing to this ministry. So, I am happy to inform the parish that four religious Sisters will be moving to St. Vincent de Paul Parish this Summer!

As we enter into this new ministry with these Franciscan Sisters, I ask all of us to offer a prayer of thanksgiving! God has blessed our parish and all of us in the Cape Girardeau area. Two of the Sisters will be doing ministry at St. Vincent de Paul Parish and School. A third Sister will be in Jackson at Immaculate Conception School, and a fourth Sister will be assigned to another parish in the area.

There will be more information regarding the Sisters and their arrival. May our hearts be filled with Easter joy for this special blessing. May the spirit of St. Francis of Assisi continue to give life to the Poor Clare Missionary Sisters as they begin this new apostolate here in our parish. May the Spirit of the Risen Lord Jesus continue to bless all of us, but especially these great women of faith who dare to live the Good News of the Gospel!

**REPORTING PROCEDURES OF KNOWN
OR SUSPECTED ABUSE OR MISCONDUCT**

Any known or suspected **abuse or neglect of a minor** must first be immediately reported to the **Missouri Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-3738**. Any known or suspected **abuse or neglect of an adult** must first be immediately reported to the **Missouri Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline at 800-392-0210**. **In situations of immediate danger, call 911.**

Known or suspected abuse may also be reported to law enforcement in addition to making a report to the MO Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline or to the MO Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline.

Violations of the Code of Conduct should also be reported to the Director of the Office of Child and Youth Protection at **childandyouthprotection@dioscg.org**; or **417-866-0841**; or through the **TIPS** online reporting system, available on the diocesan website: **ww.dioscg.org**.

Violations involving the Bishop should be reported to the Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting System at 800-276-1562 or **https://reportbishop.abuse.org/**.

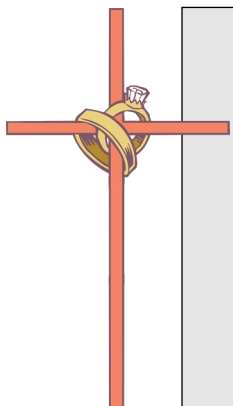
**REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL DIOCESAN PERSONNEL
(CLERGY, EMPLOYEES AND ADULT VOLUNTEERS)**

The mission and ministry of creating a safe environment for all to flourish and thrive is a responsibility everyone shares. Before regularly working or volunteering with minors or vulnerable adults, all diocesan personnel are required to first 1) complete the Safe Environment Training; 2) have a Background Screening conducted; and, 3) sign and submit the current Code of Conduct.

The Safe Environment training is now available online after creating an account in the VIRTUS system: **https://www.virtusonline.org/virtus/**.

The Code of Conduct, which is required annually and made available at the beginning of every school year, the Background Disclosure and Authorization, as well as all other required Safe Environment Policies and forms are available on the diocesan website, under the Office of Child and Youth Protection: **https://dioscg.org/child-youth-protection/**.
