Please follow the online steps to read the new Code of Conduct for 2026-2027. (If you unable to get online, please come by the parish office for a copy of the form.)

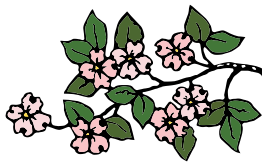
1. Go to: virtusonline.org
2. Log into your account using your ID and password.
3. Click on the Required Documents Box “Missing Code of Conduct”.
4. Read the Code of Conduct and print out the last page.
5. Answer the five questions and initial where needed. Then using an original signature (not computer generated) sign and date the bottom of the form.
6. Return to the parish office as soon as possible.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Greetings to you in the peace and love of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Next weekend, I will have the privilege of visiting your parish as part of the Missionary Cooperative Plan Appeal. My name is Most Rev. Anthony Das Pilli, and I serve as the Coadjutor Bishop of the Diocese of Nellore in South India.

The Diocese of Nellore serves a total population of nearly **8.2 million people** living across hundreds of villages, among whom nearly **100,000 are Catholics**. Many families struggle with poverty, unemployment, sickness, and lack of education. Yet in the midst of these hardships, the Church continues to be a source of faith, hope, and compassion. Following the example of Christ, we extend our pastoral, educational, medical, and charitable services to everyone who comes to us for support, regardless of religion, caste, or background.

Through the grace of God and the generosity of benefactors, our Diocese carries out many charitable ministries among the poorest and most vulnerable:

- Catholic schools with 154 teachers educating more than 5,200 children
- Boarding homes caring for nearly 1,500 poor children
- English-medium schools in remote villages providing quality education to poor families
- Homes for mentally and physically challenged children
- Care and education for deaf and speech-impaired children
- Three rehabilitation centers serving more than 125 leprosy-affected families
- Scholarships for poor students and housing assistance for struggling families

Construction Update St. Vincent Parish Family Center

The renovation of the old Notre Dame High School into our new Parish Family Center will create a welcoming home for many of our parish ministries for future generations to come. When complete, the Parish Family Center will house the parish office, a small day chapel, multiple meeting rooms for ministry groups, and a banquet hall that will serve as venue for future wedding receptions, Baptismal celebrations, family reunions, bereavement dinners, Lenten fish fries, Advent By Candlelight, parish/family missions, and other parish and community events. The existing gymnasium will remain and will be enhanced with new locker rooms and restrooms. (These will be on the same level of the gymnasium.) New entrances, windows, and exterior improvements will give the building a fresh, updated appearance while preserving its important role within our parish family.

To help guide this part of the project, the parish conducted a competitive selection process by requesting qualifications from construction management firms. Four qualified firms submitted proposals, and each was interviewed. After careful discussion and prayerful consideration, the Parish Construction Team, together with myself, selected Sides Construction of Jackson, Missouri, to serve as the parish's construction manager.

Sides Construction has been working alongside the architect since the early stages of planning, assisting with budgeting, scheduling, project coordination, and constructability reviews. They will continue to oversee construction activities, coordinate the work of subcontractors, and work closely with the parish and design team to help ensure the project is completed efficiently and within the approved project budget of \$6.9 million.

At this time of mid-July, demolition is approximately 90% complete, and Sides Construction is actively finalizing agreements with subcontractors as the project moves into the construction phase.

To date, the parish has paid \$71,250 for project mobilization and demolition. Future payments will be made as construction milestones are completed in accordance with the construction contract.

Over the next few weeks, parishioners will begin to see increased activity as crews mobilize and prepare for construction. During this time, portions of the parking area on the north side of the Parish Family Center will be affected. We appreciate your patience, understanding, and continued prayers as we work to improve our facilities for the benefit of our parish family's great resources and treasures!
