This effort is conducted in every parish of the diocese to help finance the activities and ministries of the Catholic Church in southern Missouri. 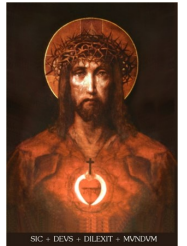
Our next meeting will be on **Wednesday, August 5**, and the topic will be **The Nicene Creed: Where It Came From and Why It Matters**.
