Welcome to Parish School of Religion Grades 1-8

Welcome to Wednesday Parish School of Religion (PSR). Classes for the 2026-2027 school year will begin on **Wednesday, September 23**, and will continue through May, 2027. This program is designed to assist students and their families, Grades 1 - 8, in the religious education of children attending public schools and homeschooled students.

Classes will be held in the school building. Doors will open at 5:45 p.m. Parents will need to sign all students in and out of each class (all grades). Parents are asked to meet their children in their classrooms at 7:30 p.m.

Registration forms may be found in the gathering area of the church. Please complete the form and bring it to the first class. Students must have completed registration forms before they may attend class. Families should be registered members of St. Vincent de Paul Parish. The first class will be Wednesday, September 23, 2026, and will begin in the school gym with a short prayer time and then conclude in the student's classrooms.

Sacrament Preparation - Preparation for First Communion is a two-year program. The first year is an introduction to the faith. The second year prepares the child for First Reconciliation and First Communion.

Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation begins with a review of all sacraments in Grade 7. The child prepares for Confirmation in Grade 8.

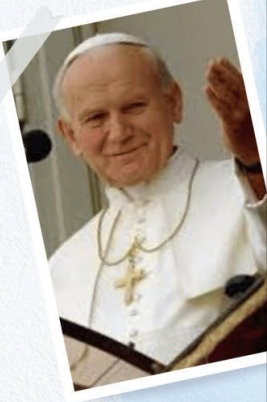
